Note to Parents and Students

Falls and other incidents may occur which can result in serious injury or death. Participants **MUST ASSUME** the inherent risks of the sport.

Following all rules and procedures can reduce the risk of injury. Failure to follow the rules will result in the student being asked to stop the activity immediately and may result in the group being asked to leave the property.
